Marcum Women's Forum to feature a Clinton

Marcum tapped a Clinton to speak at its upcoming Women's Forum.

Chelsea Clinton will headline the second annual event, set for Oct. 27 in Manhattan.

The accounting firm launched the breakfast event geared to high-net-worth and executive women last year with featured speaker Erin Brockovich.

The conference is hosted by the accounting firm's family wealth services practice and the Marcum Women's Initiative, an amalgam of programs to support the advancement and retention of women at the firm.

This year's conference is entitled "Women Having a Voice: Our Health, Our Earth, Our Strength." Clinton, whose topic will be "Our Strength," will speak in her capacity as vice chair of the Clinton Foundation, for which the empowerment of women is a central tenet. Also speaking are Lisa Garcia, vice president of litigation for Earthjustice, who will cover the "Our Earth" piece and Jeanne Rizzo, president of Breast Cancer Prevention Partners, who returns to the conference to discuss "Our Health."

Only 200 tickets will be offered by invitation only to the event, which will be held at the Convene Conference Center at 730 Third Ave. Tickets are \$125 per person, with net proceeds benefiting the Marcum Foundation, which supports nonprofit organizations in communities nationwide where Marcum has offices.

Marcum, which has major operations in Melville, is based in Manhattan.
